### Overview

This program provides employees with the ability to participate in, and complete a good Job Safety Analysis. Our program has been successfully adopted and implemented Worldwide by companies including Santos, Hess and Eni

### Course Objectives

On completion of the program, employees are able to:

1. Identify situations that require completion of a JSA;
2. Describe the use of the *Think 6, Look 6* process in preparing a JSA; and
3. Record and implement a JSA.

<b>Pre-requisite:</b>	Basic Hazard Awareness Program
<b>Suggested Audience:</b>	Supervisors and Operations personnel
<b>Duration:</b>	4 hours
<b>Class size:</b>	Minimum 6 and a maximum of 12. Ten persons is ideal
<b>Delivery mode:</b>	In-house classroom delivery using exercises
