



↘ Preliminary Risk Assessment

Overview

This program provides employees with the ability to utilize *Think 6, Look 6* during a formal assessment of risk. It provides people with the ability to participate in high-quality Preliminary Risk Assessments (using the qualitative method).

Course Objectives

On completion of the program, employees are able to:

1. Identify situations that require completion of a Qualitative Risk Assessment;
2. Describe the use of the *Think 6, Look 6* process in preparing a Qualitative Risk Assessment; and
3. Record the results of a Qualitative Risk Assessment.

Pre-requisite: Basic Risk Awareness and experience in completing JSA

Suggested Audience: EHS Staff, Supervisors and Project Engineers & Managers

Duration: 4 hours

Class size: Minimum 6 and a maximum of 12. Ten persons is ideal
